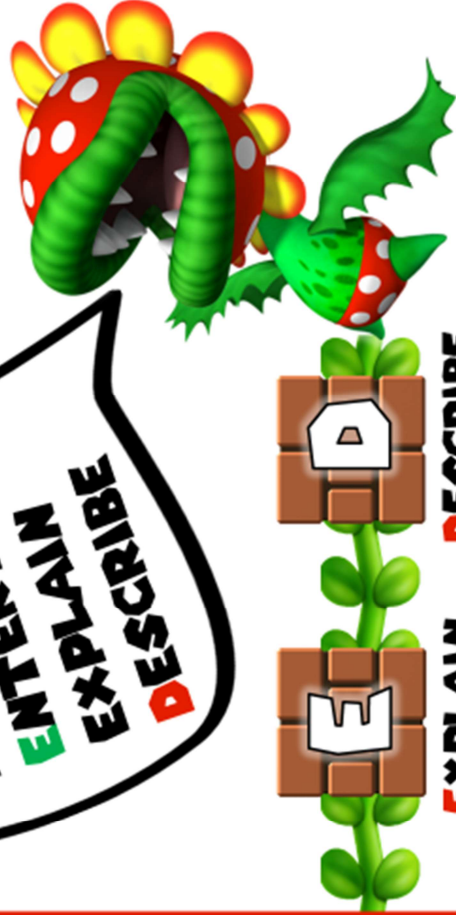

He gives directions how to do something.

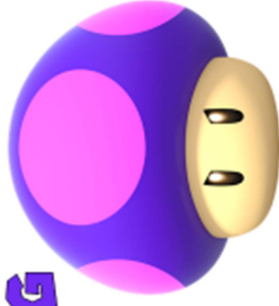
